# **Tips of the Month**

# Handy tips for newbies or experienced handlers

When you dog has had difficulty learning a move or sequence and finally gets it, stop & reward now so they know \*\*this\*\* is what you want. Even better "jackpot" them – several small treats are much better than one larger one. One treat is one treat. Two or three (or lots) is a jackpot. Be sure those are given one by one, not as one pile (one treat to the dog).
