Tips of the Month

Donna Hoffmeister & Handy tips for newbies or experienced handlers Try practicing with your dog without verbal commands. You'll be surprised how much your dog is following your body language.

What does that mean?

Jump Height For courses or events that include jumps, the height of the jump bars is determined by the dog's height at the withers (high point of neck-shoulder area). A dog may have different jump heights depending on the organization, event and class entered. You will be asked, in some sports, to have your dog measured, at 2 different times, to record their permanent jump height card. Once you have the jump height card you won't need to have your dog measured again. In other events, if your dog is tall enough for the maximum jump height, they won't need to be measured.
